COOKIES POLICY

What are "cookies"?

Cookies are computer data, particularly text files, stored on end-user devices intended for use with websites. These files allow the user's device to be recognized and the website to be displayed appropriately, tailored to their individual preferences. Cookies typically contain the name of the website they originate from, the duration of their storage on the end-user device, and a unique number.

What do we use cookies for?

Cookies are used to tailor the content of websites to user preferences and optimize the use of websites. They are also used to create anonymous, aggregated statistics that help us understand how users use websites, enabling us to improve their structure and content, excluding personal identification of users.

What cookies do we use?

Two types of cookies are used: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Persistent cookies are temporary files that remain on the user's device until the user logs out of the website or disables the software (web browser). Persistent cookies remain on the user's device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until the user manually deletes them. Cookies used by the website operator's partners, including website users, are subject to their own privacy policies.

Do cookies contain personal data?

Personal data collected using cookies may only be collected to perform specific functions for the user. Such data is encrypted to prevent unauthorized access.

Deleting "Cookies"

By default, web browsing software allows cookies to be placed on your device. These settings can be changed to block the automatic handling of cookies in your web browser settings or to notify you each time they are sent to your device. Detailed information about the possibilities and methods of managing cookies is available in your software (web browser) settings. Limiting the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the website.

How do I delete cookies in my web browser?

Mozilla Firefox

The default settings for Mozilla Firefox allow cookies to be stored. To change your settings:

- click the "Tools" menu (in other versions: click the "Firefox" button) and select "Options";
- 2. then select the "Privacy" tab and select the desired settings;

3. to enter special settings for a given website, click "Exceptions" and choose your own settings for websites; 4. confirm the changes by clicking the "OK" button.

Microsoft Edge / Internet Explorer

The default settings of Microsoft Internet Explorer allow cookies to be stored, but block files that may come from websites that do not apply a privacy policy. To change your settings:

- 1. click the "Tools" menu and select "Internet Options";
- 2. select the "Privacy" tab;
- 3. use the slider to specify the desired settings level (the highest blocks cookies completely, the lowest allows all cookies to be stored);

OR:

- 1. click the "Advanced" button and select the desired settings yourself;
- 2. to enter specific settings for a given website, click "Sites" and select your own settings for websites;
- 3. confirm the changes by clicking the "OK" button.

Google Chrome

The default settings of the Google Chrome browser allow cookies to be stored. To change your settings, follow these steps:

- 1. Click the "Google Chrome Settings" menu and select "Settings";
- 2. Click "Show advanced settings" at the bottom of the page;
- 3. Select "Content settings" in the "Privacy" options;
- 4. Select the desired settings;
- 5. To enter special settings for a given website, click "Manage exceptions" and choose your own settings for websites;
- 6. To confirm the changes, click the "Done" button.

Opera

The default settings of the Opera browser allow cookies to be stored. To change settings:

- 1. click "Preferences," select "Advanced," and then "Cookies";
- 2. select the desired settings;
- to enter specific settings for a given website, go to the selected website, right-click on it, select "Website Preferences," go to the "Cookies" tab, and then enter the desired settings;
- 4. confirm changes by clicking "OK."

Safari

The default settings of the Safari browser allow cookies to be stored. To change your settings:

- 1. in the "Safari" menu, select "Preferences";
- 2. click the "Privacy" icon;
- 3. select the desired settings;
- 4. to enter specific settings for a given website, click "Details" and choose your own settings for websites.
